## Journal's Impact IF Trend



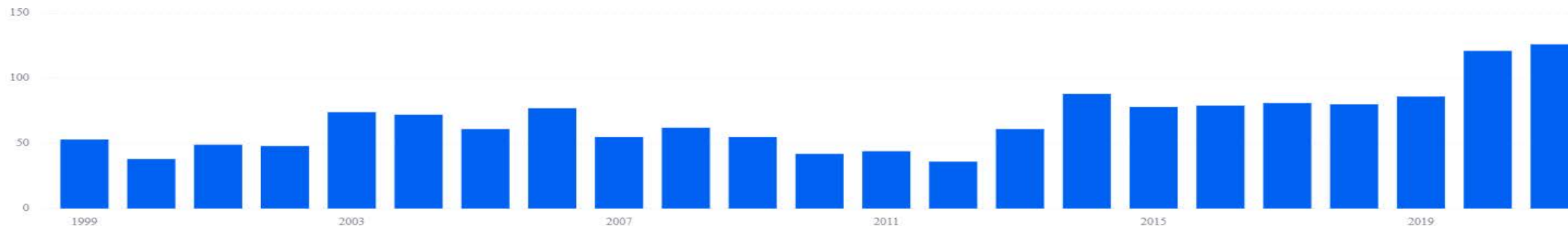

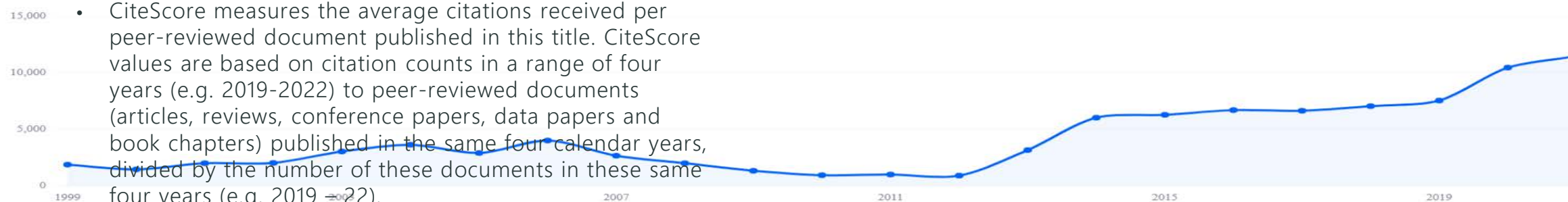
