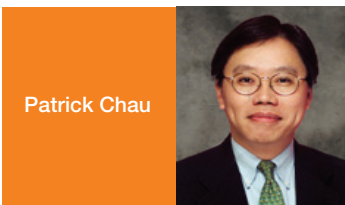

The hosting organization is the Korea Society of Management Information Systems (KMIS), which is the largest IS professional institute in Korea.

We are especially pleased with the combination of notable keynote speakers. A special “thank you” goes to Il Im and Hee - Woong Kim who have wonderfully managed all of the complex logistics and have maintained the website. Welcome Message from the Program Co-Chairs

Welcome to Jeju Island and the 17th Pacific Asia Conference on Information Systems (PACIS 2013) !

Over the years, PACIS has consolidated its position as the premier annual information systems (IS) conference in the Pacific Asia region (Region 3 of the AIS). It offers a great opportunity for researchers to exchange research findings on the latest development in the IS field, and to foster regional and international collaboration within the community. The theme of PACIS 2013 is "Smart, Open, and Social Information Systems."

Record-breaking is the keyword to describe this year's PACIS. In total, 583 manuscripts, 441 regular and 142 research-in-progress papers, were received from authors in 38 countries and regions. This submission number is a 10% increase over the previous record of 529 submissions to PACIS 2011 in Brisbane, Australia. The top 10 contributing countries and regions are China, Australia, Taiwan, Korea, USA, Malaysia, Germany, Singapore, Hong Kong, and New Zealand. As of June 7th, 498 participants have registered for the conference, which is another record-breaking number. These numbers reflect a significant growing trend of the IS community in the Asia Pacific region.

Among the 22 tracks, the most popular were "Social Media and Business Impact" (58 submissions), "Knowledge Management and Business Intelligence" (57 submissions), and "Electronic and Mobile Businesses" (47 submissions). Most appropriately, these tracks were representative of the conference theme on social, smart, and open IS. Each manuscript received at least two double-blind reviews and a final recommendation from the track chairs. The overall acceptance rate was 46.1% for regular and research-in-progress papers combined. A total of 217 regular papers and 52 research-in-progress papers were accepted in the end.

Needless to say it would not have been possible to handle the record-breaking number of submissions without the tremendous effort of numerous volunteers. In particular, we would like to express our profound gratitude to the 55 track chairs, who worked extremely hard to manage the review process. Many of them rose heroically to the challenge of handling the unexpectedly high number of manuscripts. We would also like to express our gratitude to all the reviewers who contributed their precious time in doing the reviews, and to all the authors who submitted their work. We also thank the Best Paper Selection Committee, consisting of senior scholars, such as Patrick Chau, Guy Gable, Susanna Ho, Atreyi Kankanhalli, Michael Myers, and Peter Seddon, for choosing the winners of the Best Paper Award.

Finally, we express our sincere appreciation to the Conference Co-Chairs, Ho Geun Lee and Patrick Chau, for their great support of the work of the Program Co-Chairs.

We are excited about the intellectually stimulating program, which features four keynote speeches and seven pre-conference workshops, besides the paper presentations, and wish everyone will enjoy the conference and the hospitality of the host, the Korea Society of Management Information Systems (KMIS).

Welcome Message from the Doctoral Consortium Co-Chairs

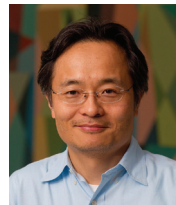
Welcome to the Pacific Asia Conference on Information Systems Doctoral Consortium for 2013 !

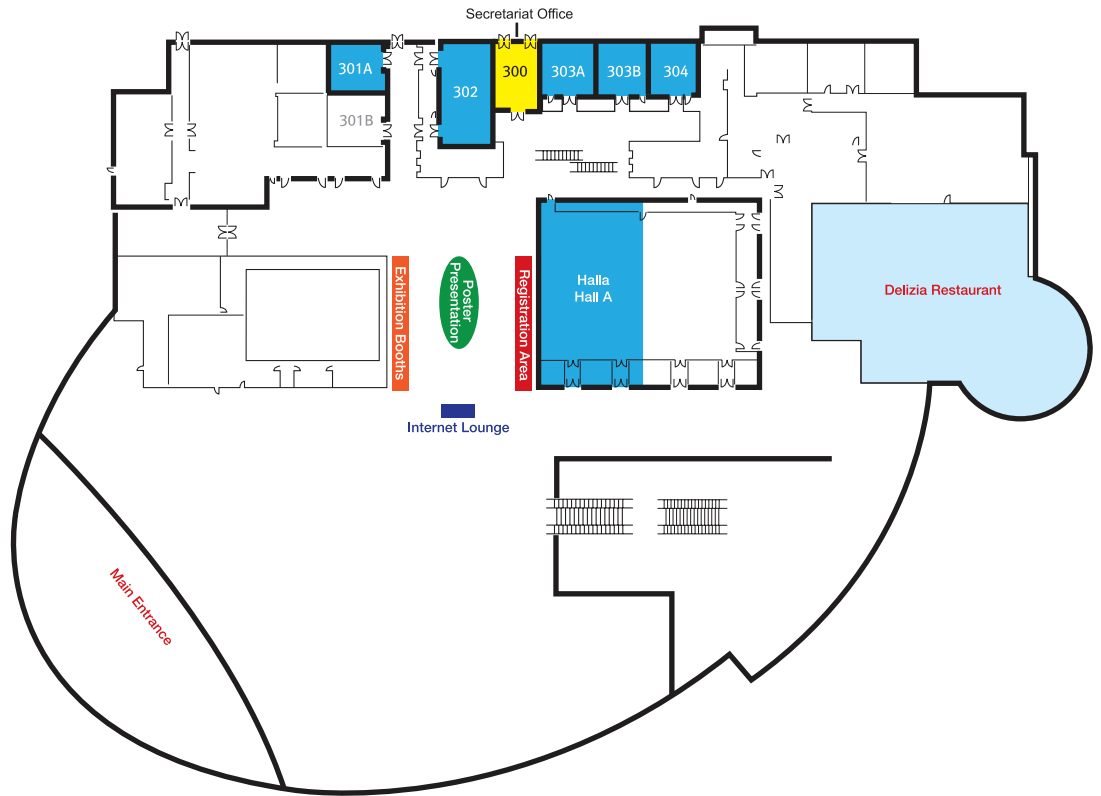

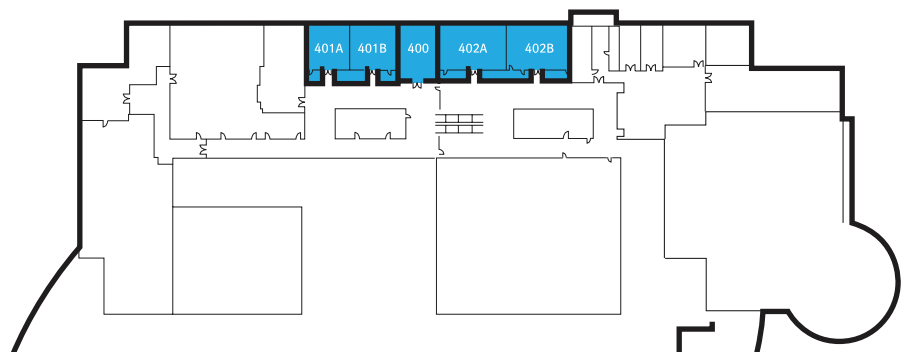
